



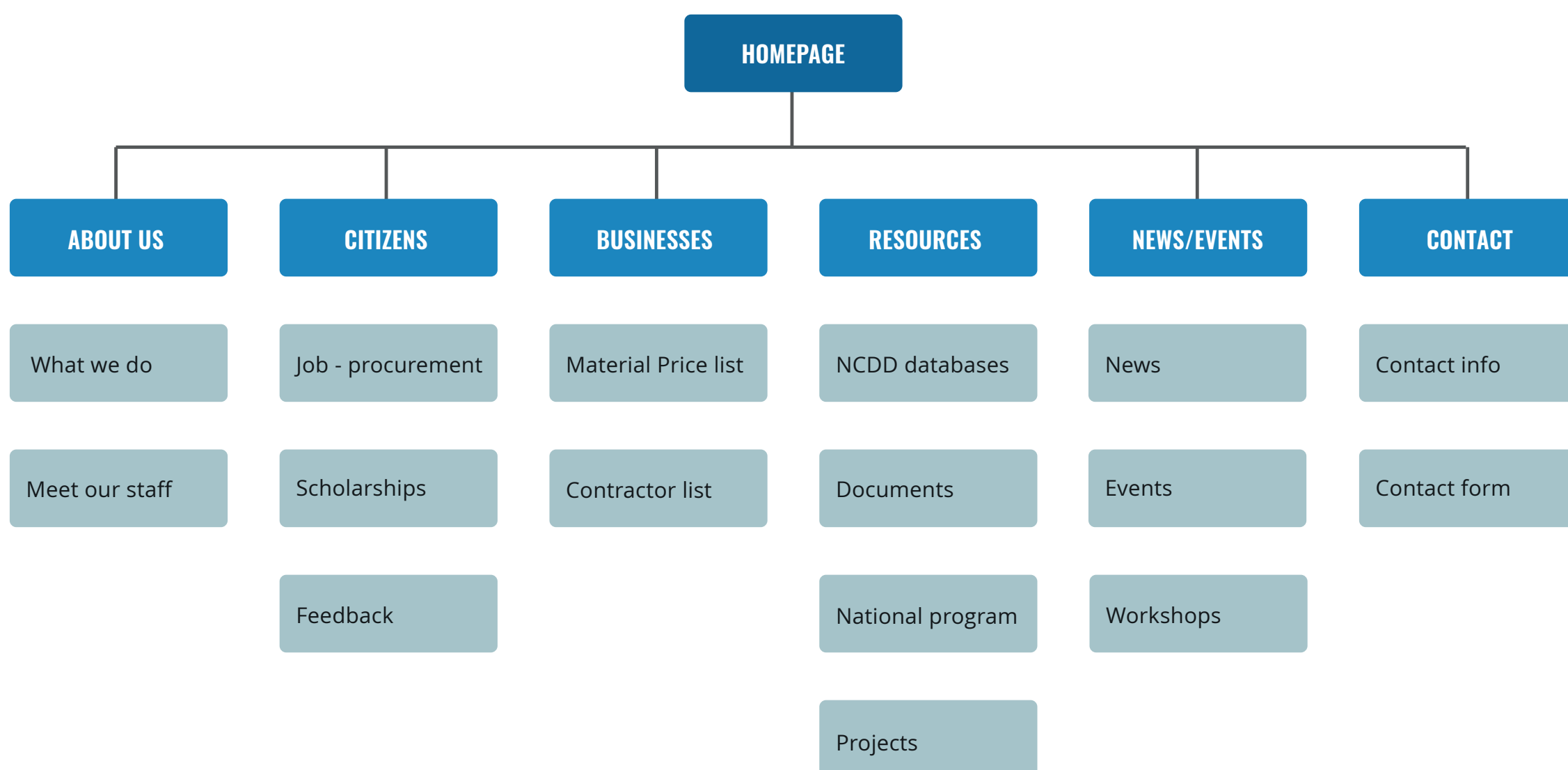
## 1. ISSUES WITH THE CURRENT NCDD WEBSITE

**Documents:** List all legal / policy documents. Day to day reports and policies would be filed here. This will also have to be organized, and a search tool devised.

**National program:** All documents about the national program. This would static documents, including the IP3, training docs, the royal decree. Documents that set the framework NCDD is governed by.

**Projects:** All information about projects.

**Contact:** General contact form for citizens, also showing contact details for key staff. Media centre should provide links to social media, press releases and person for journalists to contact.

**Help:** A help tool for people lost on website. Should provide a guide of where things are, contact details for further assistance.

**Message from chairman:** This can go in "meet our staff". We will do a short profile on the chairman, along with other key staff here.

2011-2013 IP3, 2015-2017 IPS2/3, NP-SNDD 2010-2019: This would all go under "**National Program**" which has been moved to the "resources" tab.

Planning, human resource management, budget transfer, function transfer, governance: All shifted to "**Documents**" under the resources tab as they are all policy documents.

Law, royal decree, sub decree, prakas, decision, guideline, letter, bylaw, awpb, report, training docs, cdb scorecards: **All shifted to Documents.**

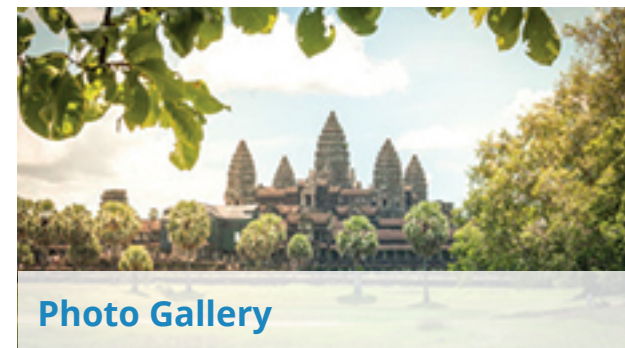

## Stakeholder Presentation on Proposed Initiatives for Sub-National Climate Change Adaptation Financing

Published on Wednesday, 02 March 2016



Phnom Penh, 29th February 2016: Cambodia is one of the first countries to Pilot LoCAL mechanism. The Local Government Climate Change (LGCC) was designed to support the capacity of the LoCal Government to implement the Climate Change Adaptation to increase the resilience at the local level. As the result of the phase I and the phase II of the project with the support from EU GCCA and SIDA, LGCC has demonstrated that the Performance Based Grant Mechanism (PBCRG) has increase the government capacity to produce the local infrastructure which contributed to increase the resilience of their commuity to the climate change effect in their area.

With 5 years experiences in implementing the programme, LGCC has improved the mechanism and improved the capacity of the local government, at the same time it also influenced the policy in mainstreaming CCA into the local government planning and also the role of local government in implementing the CCA. The new guideline of the local government planning was approved in the beginning of the year where the CC intervention will be a part of the normal development planning.

Currently, LoCAL/LGCC is entering the phase III of its implementation where the national government will access the resources (climate finance) directly and channel it to their local government. At this phase the sustainability of the programme will start, where the mechanism introduced to the project will be adopted and implemented by the government to scale up the programme to all LGs especially the one which is more vulnerable to the climate change.

NCDD as the implementing partner of the programme has been nominated by the Cambodian government to be the first National Implementing Entities (NIE) for Green Climate Fund (GCF) to apply for the GCF direct access to scale up the LGCC programme to more local government. NCDD has been registered as the candidate NIE and the draft proposal for the GCF Enhance Direct Access has been developed.

A workshop to facilitate a wide consultation of the proposal has been conducted at NCDD Secretariat, with 40 participants from Department of Climate Change, NCDS, CCCA, MoE, MEF, UNCDF, UNDP, SIDA, WB, ADB, SDC, Battambang Administration, Takeo Administration, National Committee for Local Councilor and NCDD Secretariat teams. The meeting was chaired by H.E. Ngan Chamroeun, Deputy Executive Head of NCDD.

## LASED (WB)

### Introduction

**1.1 The Land Allocation for Social and Economic Development Project (LASED)** is a project to support the implementation of the Royal Government's Social Land Concessions (SLC) Program to distribute land to the landless and land-poor through social land concessions to improve livelihood of poor households and vulnerable groups through Commune Based Social Land Concession. LASED Project is implemented by NCDD Secretariat and the General Secretariat for Social Land Concessions (GSSLC) in accordance with provisions of Article IV of the General Conditions incorporated in the Financing Agreement between Kingdom of Cambodia (RGC) and International Development Association (IDA). The project period is five years, July 2008 to June 2013, and project cost is US\$ 11.50 million. In addition, LASED has been implementing in Kratie, Kampong Cham and Kampong Thom. The objectives of LASED are to:

- Distribute state land suitable for agriculture, together with appropriate support services to qualified landless and land-poor households; and
- Introduce and implement a transparent and standardized process for expanded implementation of locally initiated social land concessions.

### 1.2 Implementation of LASED respects the following principles:

- Promote good governance and rule of law;
- Support and strengthen the land reform agenda of the Government;
- Encourage civic engagement;
- Prevent environmental degradation;
- Promote transparency and accountability; and
- Ensure sustainable growth.

### 1.3 LASED has three quantitative indicators those guide project performance and provides criteria to assess progress and success of the project.

- Numbers of SLC target communes -20,
- Numbers of Target Land Recipient (TLRs) who resettle in the SLC - 3000 households, and
- Size of SLC -10,000 hectares.

### 1.4 Project activities are divided into four components

First component is related to the commune based social land concession planning and land allocation. This component covers cost of training, incremental operating costs, goods, and contracted technical services to commune councils to prepare plans for SLC sub-projects.

Second component concerns on rural development services and investments. This component is to provide subproject grants for the commune councils, and to cover cost of civil works, goods, technical assistance and training services identified in approved SLC sub-project plans.

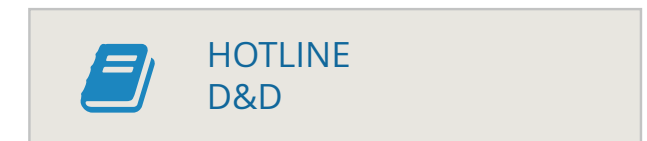
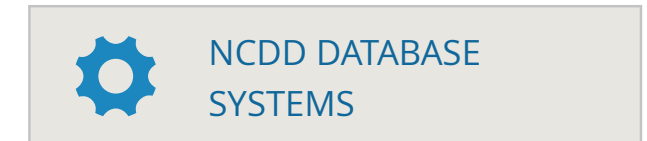
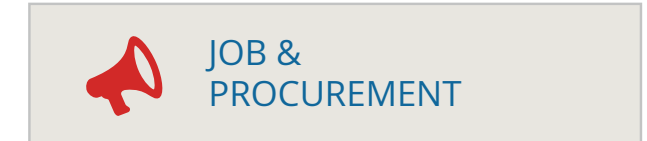
